



Institutional Sustainability Program

This program has three projects. The following is a description of the most important activities and achievements of each.

Total Commitement

Objective:

Renew the governing bodies of EDUCA NETWORK schools.

Benefited population:

227 people from governing bodies, general directors and fundraisers from the 34 schools of EDUCA NETWORK and guests.

Activities performed:

- Total Commitment began in November 2020 with the Workshop for Governing Bodies of EDUCA NETWORK. It lasted three hours and was taught by EDUCA advisors, José Antonio Casas-Alatriste and Gonzalo Turueño Senosian. The central theme of the Workshop was to promote high performance councils/boards, as well as the recruitment and involvement of new directors.
- We virtually held EDUCA NETWORK's Fifth Conference on Institutional Strengthening. This eventwasaimedatgoverningbodies, general directors and fundraisers. It consisted of a space for reflection, collaboration and training on topics related to organizational strategy and fundraising.

The Conference's main activities were:

- 2 Keynote Conferences: "The importance of the common good in times of pandemic" with Julio Di- Bella Roldán and "Fundraising" with Bernard Ross, The Management Centre, United Kingdom. Three simultaneous workshops: Emotional Containment for Work Teams from Top Management, Design Your Digital Fundraising Campaign, and Financial and Operational Resilience in COVID Contexts.
- For the first time, we held the "María Alicia Corcuera Award for Fundraiser of the Year" contest.
- Conversation: "Transforming education from civil society" with the participation of representatives of the Alberto Bailleres Foundation, EXCELDUC, Mexicanos Primero and Vía Educación.
- We presented the conmemorative book and video for the Foundation's 25th anniversary: 25 years, 25 stories.
- We held the "Everyone in EDUCA NETWORK Believes They Know" contest in which several school representatives put their knowledge to the test.
- We closed the day with a virtual celebration for EDUCA's 25 year anniversary.

Results:

 227 general directors, fundraisers and members of governing bodies were trained to strengthen the fundraising and management of EDUCA NETWORK schools.









Objective:

Increase the flow of recurring donations via credit or debit card.

Benefited population:

27 institutions in EDUCA NETWORK benefiting 8,356 students.

Activities performed:

- \$4 x \$1 Campaign. This campaign lasted 4 months, from October 2019 to February 2020 and the objective was for the institutions to reach a goal of \$100,000 from new and recurring donations. As an incentive, EDUCA granted \$4 x \$1 for each new peso obtained by the institutions..
- EDUCA Fund Appeal. This fund is granted each year to 4 institutions as of an appeal. The objective is to invest that resource in a project that improves the fulfillment of the Institutional Strengthening Program to strengthen the schools' work. In 2020, the EDUCA Fund was granted to Gota de Leche, A.C., Instituto de Educación Integral, I.A.P. San Juan Pablo II, Centro Educativo La Buena Tierra, A.C., and Emotional Training Center, LFH, A.C.

Results:

- The participating institutions achieved \$120,000 in new and recurring donations via credit and debit card. This resource was obtained from 56 new donors.
- The EDUCA Fund was invested in purchasing educational materials, paying specialized trainers, equipping a school diner and paying advisors to systematize the learning methodology to be used by one of the schools.

(Institutional Strengthening

Objective:

Implement continuous improvement processes at EDUCA NETWORK schools.

Benefited population:

43 institutions of EDUCA NETWORK, benefitting close to 12 thousand students and more than 800 teachers and directors.


Activities performed:

- All institutions conducted the institutional self-diagnosis to measure their level of organizational maturity. The self-diagnosis is done on a predictive analysis platform designed by EDUCA. It measures eight dimensions through 121 indicators.
- 20 institutions were accompanied by a coach to work on the dimensions of Fundraising, Education Quality and Education Model.
- The work of the coaches on Fundraising focused on developing the skills for planning and strategy, social entrepreneurship and sustainability, increasing unique and recurring donations, defining or strengthening the donor followup plan and implementing a fundraising campaign through a social network.
- The educational coaching focused on adapting education models to a remote education mode, promoting students' personal online growth using mediation, and defining strategies to mediate significant online learning.
- We launched the Safe School strategy to guarantee that schools in EDUCA NETWORK have the training, strategies and materials necessary to prevent, provide care and/or refer COVID-19 cases, in addition to fulfilling the requirements of health and education authorities. As part of this strategy, we conducted the first virtual workshop "How to implement safety measures and protocols during the return to schools" lasting 2 hours. With the participation of 78 directors and education coordinators from 35 schools of EDUCA NETWORK. Furthermore, we distributed 19,750 face masks at 27 schools.

People Empowerment Program

This program has 6 projects. The following is a description of the most significant activities and achievements for the programs implemented in 2020.

Save and Venture

Objective:

Ensure that girls, boys and teenagers of EDUCA NETWORK improve their economic and social reality by exercising socio-emotional, financial and entrepreneurship competencies.


Benefited population:

In 2020, the project was implemented at 16 schools, directly benefiting 120 teachers and 3,371 girls, boys and teenagers. Indirectly benefiting 5,056 parents.

Activities conducted:

- Initial training. This training had the purpose of helping coordinators and teachers understand the educational material's methodological approach, as well as updating Empowerment, Financial Health, Economic Citizenship and Entrepreneurship contents.
- Design new content. Incorporating new content designed to promote a greater emphasis on strengthening students' economic and financial competencies.
- Delivery of educational materials to students. With the aim of optimizing the use of resources, we promoted that students from 1st to 4th grades reuse materials from previous years and/or use digital versions. This year we only printed and distributed guides for students who did not have access to connectivity or lacked devices to review content remotely.
- Visit to the Interactive Museum of Economics (MIDE). The visit to MIDE is an extracurricular activity that allows elementary school students in the 4th grade to reinforce learnings related to saving, distinguishing between needs and desires, reasoned consumption and resource management. The visit was attended by 105 boys and girls, plus 12 teachers from 3 schools.






- Class hours. The Save and Venture program is implemented one hour a week. Around 25 hours of class are held throughout the school year. More than half of these sessions were carried out remotely through the use of Facebook, WhatsApp and the devices that students and teachers had on hand to work on the classes.
- Online teacher training. We offered the online course Save and Venture. The course used interaction tools that allowed teachers to exchange experiences on the implementation of the program through forums, creating presentations, infographics, comparative charts, etc. It lasted 24 hours, benefitting 64 teachers.
- Certification Process CONOCER on Competency Standard EC0670, Facilitation for the Development of economic and financial intelligence for children and teenagers. 17 teachers were certified on this standard, thus reinforcing their competencies to create, implement and evaluate their session plans.
- Follow-up visits for institutions. The follow-up visits are part of the implementation strategy to know the characteristics with which schools operate the program, the training needs of teachers and the appropriation of the Save and Venture program by girls, boys and teenagers. This year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, only the first visit was done in person and all other visits were conducted remotely.
- Save and Venture EDUCA Fair. We held the fifth edition of this event aimed at gathering girls, boys, teenagers, teachers and parents in a virtual event to share experiences, present ventures and participate in live broadcasts on financial education, entrepreneurship, empowerment and environmental care.













The activities conducted in the event are:

Entrepreneurship Contest	Girls, boys and teenagers presented entrepreneurships designed as creative solutions that help improve social, environmental, technological and/or financial issues in their school or community.
AlquiLab	Girls, boys, teenagers, teachers and parents presented social, environmental, technological and/or financial ventures that require specialized counseling or funding for their execution or growth.
EDUCA Save and Venture Fair Platform	A virtual space that gathers all of the activities program's information for the EDUCA Save and Venture Fair. It has a special section that presents the general description of the participating ventures to make them known as creative solutions designed by girls, boys, teenagers, teachers and parents.
Bootcamp	The bootcamp was an intensive training for girls, boys and teenagers whose ventures were awarded or acknowledged in the Fair. It was geared towards strengthening the soft and technical skills related to entrepreneurship.



Results:

In the final evaluation conducted for girls, boys and teenagers:

- 51% say they saved more than the previous year.
- 58% say they know how much they have saved because they keep records.
- 80% say they save in a money box and 12% say they save in a bank.
- Acknowledge that the program helps them save and plan expenses; recognize their own skills and talents; help people, schools or communities; solve problems in a respectful and peaceful manner; take care of the environment; and have a better relationship with their classmates.



Sustainable EDUCA

Objective:

Achieve to make girls, boys and teenagers carry out actions with environmental awareness.

Benefited population:

845 girls, boys and teenagers, and 68 teachers from 8 schools within EDUCA NETWORK.

Activities performed:

- Installing gardens at home: The school garden is a space for growing vegetables, installed in schools, which allows teachers and students to address topics related to nature (plants, animals, climate, among others), health (production and consumption of healthy foods) and environmental problems (water and soil care, resource use, recycling, pollution, climate change, among many others). In 2020, derived from the pandemic, the teachers made didactic adaptations to promote that the school garden known to their students becomes a garden in their home or backyard.
- Installing solar panels: Fundación Dar, I.A.P. and Voces y Visiones de Malinalco, A.C., Comunidad Educativa Ameyalli received support from EDUCA to install solar panels. With this infrastructure, schools will save 30% of the energy they usually spend. Due to the pandemic, we haven't been able to see the results but we hope to see the materialize once schools reopen.
- EDUCA NETWORK'S Eco-school Program: Eco-school is the largest sustainable schools program in the world and is part of the programs of the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE). With Eco-school, each schools follows a seven step process of change lead by students. The schools who participated in this project and earned the Green Flag the top Eco-school distinction were: Voces y Visiones de Malinalco, A.C. Comunidad Educativa Ameyalli, Niños, Niños y Adolescentes en Armonía, A.C. and Centro Comunitario Teresiano, A.C.



Schools for Earth

As part of the actions of the Sustainable EDUCA project, in 2019 EDUCA joined the Worldwide Environmental Education (WEE) initiative and has been a leader in the implementation of the Schools for Earth Program.

Schools for Earth is a comprehensive program that aims for educational centers and universities to incorporate environmental education processes and school practices designed to develop institutional and personal competencies among students, teachers, directors and parents for environmental care and sustainable development.

Activities performed

- 4 Webinars to celebrate Earth Day on April 22, and 2 more to celebrate World Environment Day on June 5:
 - The garden as an educational and innovative resource to reach SDG that gathered 7,390 attendees.
 - Environmental and climate education for action that gathered 4,157 attendees.-Mexico's actions in the 2030 Agenda and Sustainable Development Goals for girls, boys, teenagers and teachers. Gathered more than 2,000 attendees.
 - Mexican cartography, learn about Mexico's main ecosystems. Gathered more than 2,000 attendees.
- Virtual tour of the Children's Farm with a total of 1,243 attendees.
- Online calls with 109 participating students talking about their projects.
- The Cinema Planeta platform, a member of WEE, remained open for more than a month so
 that students and teachers could enjoy a great number of environmental documentaries and
 education guides.
- The Schools for Earth Contest achieved the participation of 3,298 schools in all states of the country, and the participation of 110,473 teachers and 778,790 students. We received a total of 518 projects that were evaluated by a jury specialized in Worldwide Environmental Education and EDUCA.
